Subject: Closure of Avenue G between Sierra Highway and approximately 50 Feet

East of the Railroad Tracks

Recommendation:

Approve the closure of Avenue G between Sierra Highway and approximately 50 feet east of the railroad tracks, for a period not to exceed 5 days to facilitate the construction of the Avenue G street improvements related to the eSolar project.

Background:

Sierra Suntower, LLC, has requested approval for the temporary road closure of Avenue G between Sierra Highway and approximately 50 feet east of the railroad tracks to construct the Avenue G street improvements. Avenue G is a shared jurisdiction with the County of Los Angeles.

The Contractor/Developer is required to acquire approval from all jurisdictions prior to closing the roadway. This closure is being requested for public safety. The detour route around the project provides safe passage with a minimal delay. The south half of the street will be removed during construction leaving only one lane intact for traffic. Flagging will be provided 24/7 for local residents to access the north side of Avenue G from Division Street. All emergency access, City services, and residential access will be provided at all times.
