Subject: Vacation of Road Right-of-Way, a Portion of Date Avenue, Located North

of Kettering Street and South of Jackman Street

Recommendation:

Adopt **Resolution No. 10-02**, declaring its intention to vacate a portion of road right-of-way on Date Avenue, located north of Kettering Street and south of Jackman Street.

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Background:

The road right-of-way for Date Avenue was dedicated to the City of Lancaster as shown on MR-5-470 and 471. With the development of American Heroes Park to the west, the City no longer needs the road right-of-way and the proposed vacation will allow the unneeded property to revert to the fronting properties. On May 18, 2009, the Lancaster Planning Commission determined that the subject road right-of-way vacation was in conformance with the General Plan.

In order to proceed with the road right-of-way vacation, Staff recommends February 23, 2010, be set as the date of the public hearing to receive testimony relative to the vacation.
