RESOLUTION NO. 10-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR ALL FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE CITY OF LANCASTER, FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, ALLOCATED FOR STREET AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,057,217

WHEREAS, Article 8 of the Transportation Development Act provides that cities can use eligible funds of the County's Local Transportation Fund for local streets and road expenditures when the City's unmet transportation needs have been satisfied;

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has met its unmet public transportation needs through an agreement with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority to provide public transportation in the City of Lancaster;

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster desires to use its portion of its allocation of Transportation Development Act funds for minor street and road improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Lancaster and is the City's designated contact person.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to, and shall, apply for all funds available to the City of Lancaster allocated for street and road improvements for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 in the total amount of \$4,057,217.00.
