

ORDINANCE NO. 943

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.34 AND 2.30 OF THE LANCASTER MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXTEND THE SUNSET PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted Chapter 2.34 of the Lancaster Municipal Code establishing the Architectural and Design Planning Commission;

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted Chapter 2.30 of the Lancaster Municipal Code establishing the Criminal Justice Commission;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to extend the sunset provisions of such chapters.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.34.100 is hereby added to Chapter 2.34 of the Lancaster Code to read as follows:

“Sunset. This Chapter shall terminate and be of no further force and effect on July 1, 2012 unless otherwise extended by resolution of the City Council prior thereto.”

Section 2. Section 2.30.100 is hereby added to Chapter 2.30 of the Lancaster Municipal Code to read as follows:

“Sunset. This Chapter shall terminate and be of no further force and effect on July 1, 2012 unless otherwise extended by resolution of the City Council prior thereto.”

Section 3. That any provision of the Lancaster Municipal Code or appendices thereto inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, is hereby repealed or modified to that extent necessary to effect the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is held for any reason to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council of the City of Lancaster hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published and posted pursuant to the provisions of law in that regard and this ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its final passage.
