Subject: Summary Approval for all Department of Resources Recycling and

Recovery (CalRecycle) Grants

Recommendation:

Adopt **Resolution No. 10-37**, approving the submittal of grant applications to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for all available used oil grants as listed under the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act or the Used Oil Payment Program (OPP).

Fiscal Impact:

The City has historically received \$35,000.00 a year on a per capita basis to promote the proper disposal and recycling of used motor oil.

Background:

CalRecycle requires that local government resolutions be submitted with each and every grant application submitted. The proposed resolution, if approved, is a blanket resolution that would be attached to all future CalRecycle grant applications. As requests for projects are released by CalRecycle for future grant applications, this will provide staff adequate time to meet the specific guidelines to submit applications without obtaining and submitting separate resolutions for each individual grant application.
