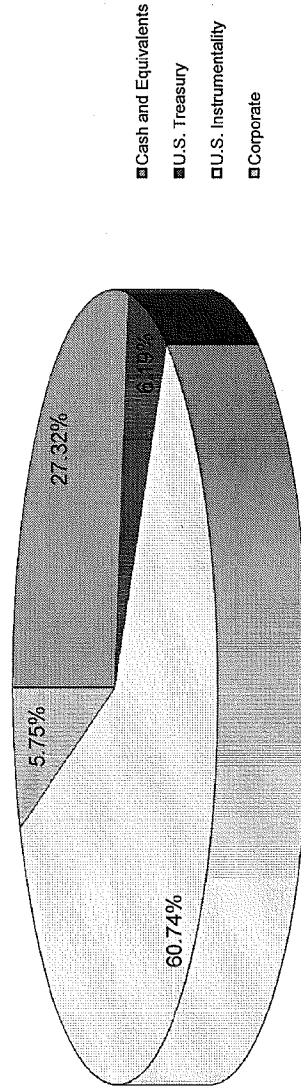

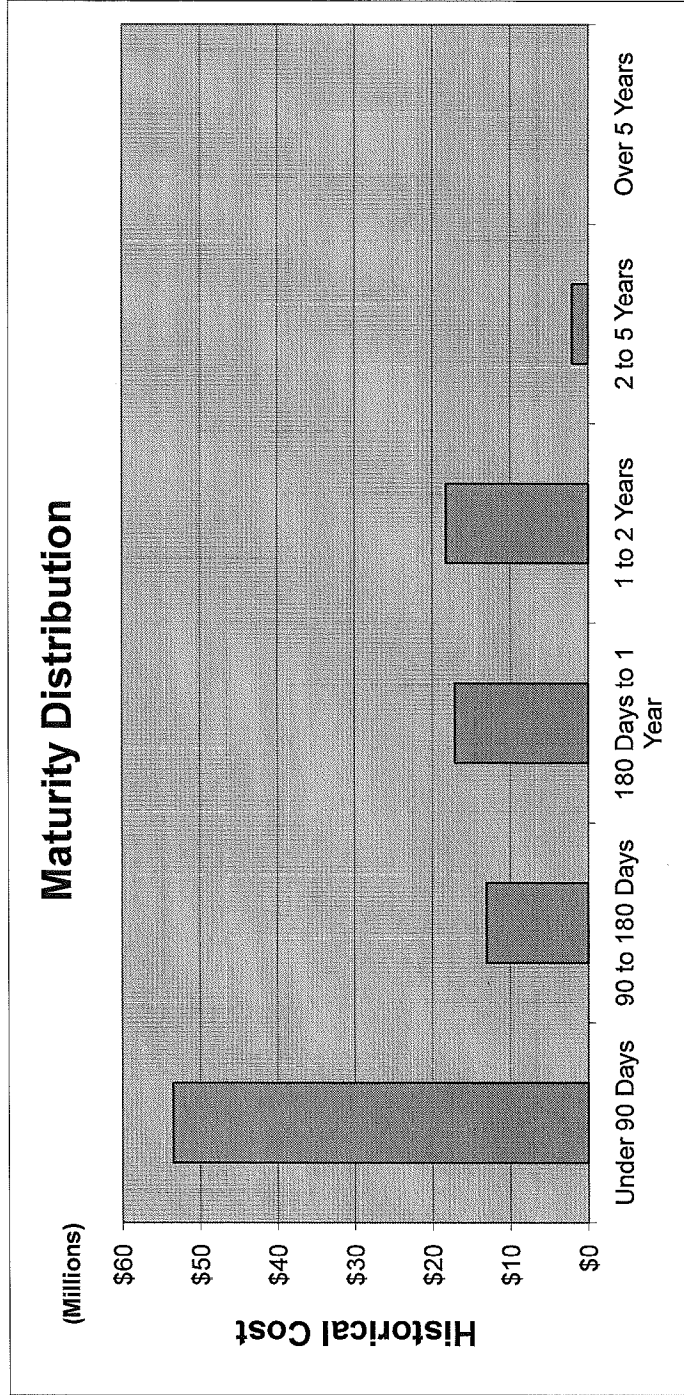

Portfolio / Segment Diversification



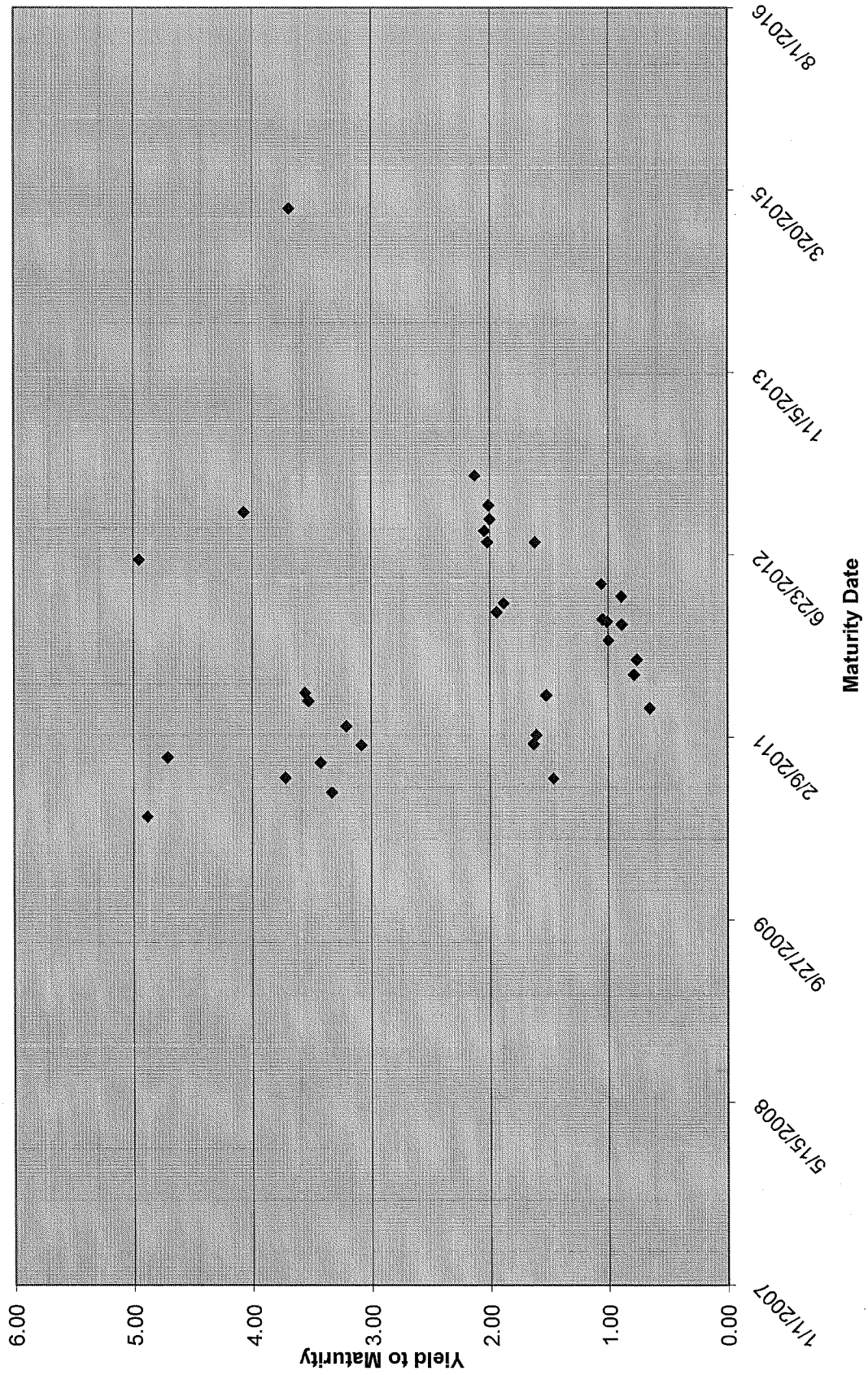
