

RESOLUTION NO. 10- 64

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THAT PORTION OF LANCASTER BLVD. BETWEEN SIERRA HIGHWAY AND 10TH STREET WEST TO BE CO-NAMED THE BLVD.

WHEREAS, the naming of streets and roads within the City of Lancaster is closely regulated to assure that citizens and visitors to the City are able to navigate without difficulty throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council from time to time may determine that naming certain physical features of the City of Lancaster after individuals or events will provide a source of pride and community recognition; and

WHEREAS, the City and the BLVD Association have requested the portion of Lancaster Blvd. between Sierra Highway and 10th Street West to be co-named "The BLVD" so as to reflect the rebranding in Downtown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, THAT:

Section 1. The portion of Lancaster Blvd. between Sierra Highway and 10th Street West, hereafter shall be co-named "The BLVD".

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution, attested to by the City Clerk under the seal of this City, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THAT PORTION OF ELM AVENUE BETWEEN KETTERING STREET AND MILLING STREET TO BE CO-NAMED EHRLICH AVENUE

WHEREAS, the naming of streets and roads within the City of Lancaster is closely regulated to assure that citizens and visitors to the City are able to navigate without difficulty throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council from time to time may determine that naming certain physical features of the City of Lancaster after individuals or events will provide a source of pride and community recognition; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested the portion of Elm Avenue between Kettering Street and Milling Street to be co-named "Ehrlich Avenue" so as to reflect the independent spirit of entrepreneurialism and unparalleled energy for innovation that Scott Ehrlich and his partners at InSite Development have manifested by making a personal investment in downtown Lancaster;
