Subject: Interim Urgency Moratorium Ordinance Extending the Moratorium

Regulating the Use of Real Property for the Sale and Distribution of

Marijuana.

Recommendation:

Adopt **Interim Urgency Ordinance No. 955**, extending a moratorium on the use of any property for the sale or distribution of marijuana and thereafter extended the period of such moratorium by the adoption of Ordinance No. 940.

Fiscal Impact:

Unknown.

Background:

The City Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 939 placing a moratorium on the use of real property for the sale or distribution of marijuana.

The attached ordinance would extend the moratorium adopted by Ordinance No. 939 and extended by Ordinance No. 940 on the use of any real property in the City of Lancaster for the purpose of selling or dispensing marijuana for a period of one year. The adoption of the ordinance requires an affirmative vote of four-fifths of the City Council. The ordinance may not be extended for any additional periods pursuant to Government Code Section 65858.
