Adopt **Ordinance No. 958,** adopting the 2010 edition of the California Building Code; the 2010 edition of the California Residential Code, the 2010 edition of the California Electrical Code; the 2010 edition of the California Mechanical Code; the 2010 edition of the California Plumbing Code; the 2010 the edition of the California Energy Code; the 2010 edition of the California Historical Building Code; the 2010 edition of the California Green Building Standards Code; the 2011 edition of the Los Angeles County Building Code, Chapter 67; the 2009 edition of the International Property Maintenance Code; the 1997 edition of the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings; and the 2011 edition of the Los Angeles County Fire Code; all pertaining to life and safety and to the construction, alteration, moving demolition, repair, maintenance, and use of buildings, structures, and properties within the City.

Fiscal Impact:

None. By adopting the 2010 California Codes, with minimal amendments, the City will place itself in a level position with other communities throughout the State. This will place the City ahead of those communities adopting more restrictive amendments.
