**Recommendation:**

Appropriate the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$105,168.00 to expense account #399-4820-354 and \$105,168.00 to revenue account #399-3308-200.

**Fiscal Impact:**

The City will receive \$105,168.00.

**Summary:**

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) will allow states and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system. The JAG purpose areas are:

- Law Enforcement Programs
- Prosecution and court programs
- Prevention and education programs
- Corrections and community corrections programs
- Drug treatment programs
- Planning, evaluation and technology improvement programs.

The JAG funds can be used in any of the six purpose areas to pay for personnel, overtime and equipments.
