Subject: **Award of Bid - Public Works Construction Project No. 06-035
Pedestrian Access Improvements FY 2006/2007**

Recommendation:

Award Public Works Construction Project No. 06-035, Pedestrian Access Improvements FY 2006/2007 to Padilla Paving Company, in the amount of \$1,123,366.00 plus a 2% contingency. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents.

Fiscal Impact:

\$1,145,833.30 (including 2% contingency); sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 15SW003.

Background:

As part of the City's ongoing efforts to upgrade pedestrian access around the city, this project is designed to perform repairs of existing defective sidewalks, and to construct new concrete sidewalks and handicap access curb ramps at various locations citywide.

On December 6, 2006, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 06-035. Four sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:

1. Padilla Paving Company	\$1,123,366.00
2. Kalban, Inc.	\$1,203,386.80
3. Granite Construction Company	\$1,388,800.00
4. MJS Construction, Inc.	\$1,648,000.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$1,119,990.00
