## **Recommendation:**

Adopt the Tax Sharing Resolutions for proposed Annexation Nos. 334, 336, 339, and 342 into Los Angeles County Sanitation No. 14.

## **Fiscal Impact:**

None.

## **Background:**

The property owners within Annexation Nos. 334, 336, 339, and 342 are requesting sewer service for their properties. Before sewer service can be provided, the properties must first be annexed into Los Angeles County Sanitation No. 14. Additionally, before annexation may be approved, the agencies already providing services to the sites must negotiate reallocation of the ad valorem taxes for the properties being annexed.

Los Angeles County Sanitation No. 14 submitted a written request that the City of Lancaster consider a joint resolution which will reallocate the ad valorem tax revenues generated by the properties within the proposed annexation. These tax sharing resolutions will provide Los Angeles County Sanitation No. 14 with property tax revenues from the properties proposed for annexation into the District for the benefit of bringing a new service into the annexed territory.
