WHEREAS, The City Council adopted Resolution No. 11-38 on June 28, 2011 to establish a Voluntary Separation Incentive Program (VSIP) to allow and incentivize employees to self-identify their willingness to voluntarily resign or retire prior to December 31, 2011;

WHEREAS, The City has employed voluntary separation incentives, attrition, and a hiring freeze as the primary means of reducing staffing since 2007;

WHEREAS, The City desires to utilize voluntary separation incentives to continue to reduce staffing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to amend the Voluntary Separation Incentive Program (VSIP) for employees within twenty four months of City retirement age to retain Public Agency Retirement System (PARS) and retiree health benefits they have already accrued.
