WHEREAS, the Agency will reflect the loan on the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule as an enforceable obligation; and

WHEREAS, the Agency and City desire to formalize this debt obligation of the Agency for the reimbursement of administrative expenses of the Agency during the period January to June 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Agency will consider a corresponding action to consider the adoption of a Successor Agency Resolution setting forth the terms and conditions of a Promissory Note (as shown on Exhibit A) in an amount sufficient to cover such expense, up to \$398,219, including authorization to the City Manager to execute said Promissory Note; and

WHEREAS, interest shall accrue on the outstanding amount at the Local Agency Investment Fund Rate (LAIF).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
