Subject: Award of Bid - Public Works Construction Project No. 07-006

**Traffic Signal Avenue I/15th Street East** 

#### **Recommendation:**

Award Public Works Construction Project No. 07-006, Traffic Signal Avenue I/15<sup>th</sup> Street East to Taft Electric Company, in the amount of \$514,010.00 (plus a 10% contingency). Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents.

### **Fiscal Impact:**

\$565,411.00 (including 10% contingency); sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvement Budget Account No. 217-16TS005-924.

## **Background:**

The project is designed to install a new traffic signal system and appurtenant street improvements at Avenue I and 15<sup>th</sup> Street East. An engineering study of traffic conditions, pedestrian characteristics, and physical characteristics of the intersection was performed and it was determined that a traffic signal was warranted at this location.

On February 14, 2007, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 07-006. Two sealed bids were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:

Taft Electric Company \$514,010.00
Freeway Electric \*\$596,904.25

Engineer's Estimate \$516,640.00
