Subject: **Award of Bid No. 568-13 – Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement Screening Materials**

Recommendation:

Award of City Bid No. 568-13 - Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement Screening Materials, to Reclaimed Aggregates, Inc., for the implementation of the City's Pavement Preservation Program.

Fiscal Impact:

\$204,988.89; sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvement Budget Account Nos. 205-12ST030-924 and 210-12ST030-924. There is no additional maintenance costs associated with this project.

Background:

On September 25, 2012, the City Council authorized the purchase of four (4) pieces of equipment for the Department of Public Works to begin implementing a shift to Pavement Preservation within the Pavement Management Program. Utilizing existing staff, the Maintenance Services Division will treat twice as many roads targeted in the Pavement Management Program for pavement preservation. The City will realize increased lane miles treated and reduced costs over conventional methods. This procurement includes materials produced by crushing asphalt concrete pavement.

On May 15, 2013, at 3:00 p.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Bid No. 568-13. One sealed bid envelope was received, opened and read aloud. The results are provided in Table 1 - Award Recommendation/Bid Comparison attached hereto.
