2014 Pavement Management Program

Recommendation:

Reject all bids for Public Works Construction Project No. 13-011, 2014 Pavement Management Program. The City has elected to revisit the existing scope of work for possible inclusion of alternate pavement preservation techniques and expanded scope of work.

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Background:

As part of the Pavement Management Program, this project was designed to repair and resurface Lancaster Blvd. from 20th Street West to 30th Street West and from Yucca Avenue to Challenger Way, Avenue J from Challenger Way to 20th Street East, and 15th Street West from Avenue K-8 to 17th Street West with a new asphalt concrete pavement surface, and curb and gutter improvements. New traffic striping was to be installed that would allow for the construction of new bike lanes, conforming to the Master Plan of Trails and Bikeways.

The City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 13-011 on August 9, 2013, at 11:00 a.m. Four sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:
