### **PRESENTATIONS**

1. Walking School Bus Program Donita Winn

Donita Winn gave a presentation on the Walking School Bus Program. The program was developed to encourage more children to walk to school while providing a safe environment for them. Several schools in the Lancaster School District have been involved in the implementation of the program and they hope to have all schools participating in the fall of 2013. This has been a collaboration of partnerships in Lancaster and will require many volunteers on a daily basis to succeed. Ms. Winn commended all that have been involved with the program.

2. Mariposa Town Hall Follow Up/UNITE Lancaster Kick Off Patti Garibay

Patti Garibay gave a brief summary of the Mariposa Neighborhood Town Hall meeting and the topics/concerns discussed with the residents. Some of the resident concerns are: not enough activities for the youth, scavenging, narcotics, vandalism and gang activities. We will look into increasing patrol in the area as well as developing more programs/activities for kids.

Ms. Garibay announced that the UNITE Program will be accepting applications from May 9th through June 14th for 2013 projects.
