A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE FORMATION OF THE "LANCASTER BUSINESS PARK LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT", AN ASSESSMENT DISTRICT TO BE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 AND CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION ARTICLE XIIID

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster, California (the "City") is a charter city and municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to initiate proceedings pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" as set forth in Part 2 of Division 15 (Sections 22500 et seq.) of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and Article XIIID of the California Constitution, to form a District in order to provide for the continued maintenance, operation and servicing of the Landscaped Areas, and all improvements thereto, and for the payment of all costs and expenses incurred for the same; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Services Manager has caused the preparation of the Engineer's Report and filed the same with the City Clerk, and the City Clerk has presented the Engineer's Report to the City Council for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby specifically finds and declares that the actions authorized hereby constitute and are with respect to public affairs of the City, and that the statements, findings and determinations of the City set forth in the preambles above and of the documents approved herein are true and correct.

Section 2. Pursuit to Section 22585 and 22605 of the Street and Highways Code of the State of California, the City hereby proposes to form, and does initiate proceedings for the formation of a District, to provide for the continued maintenance, operation and servicing of the Landscaped Areas, and all landscape improvements thereon as defined in Section 3 below and for the payment of all costs and expenses incurred for such maintenance, operation and servicing.

Section 3. The improvements to the Landscape Areas shall include such ground cover, shrubbery, trees, and other landscaping, irrigation and equipment, raised medians with stamped concrete (hereinafter referred to as "Landscape Improvements") as were required by the City.

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Section 4. To ensure that the costs and expenses of maintaining, operating and servicing the Landscape Areas and the Landscape Improvements hereon, are borne by the owners of the property to be benefited thereby, the City resolves that the proposed District shall consist of the Property referenced in Exhibit "B".

Section 5. The improvements shall consist of the cost and expenses of maintaining, operating and servicing the Landscape Areas and the Landscape Improvements thereon.

Section 6. The distinctive designation for the proposed assessment district to be formed pursuant to this Resolution shall be "Lancaster Business Park Landscape Maintenance District."

Section 7. The City hereby approves the preliminary "Engineer's Report" and the Utility Services Manager is directed to file the diagram and assessment with the City Clerk.

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster, California (the "City") is a charter city and municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the Constitution and the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has by Resolution No. 13-66, initiated proceedings for the formation of Lancaster Business Park Landscape Maintenance District pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 being Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Utility Services Manager has caused the preparation of the Engineer's Report and filed the same with the City Clerk, and the City Clerk has presented the Engineer's Report to the City Council for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the diagram and assessment have been filed with the City Clerk and are open to public inspection, and may be referred to for all details regarding the improvements, the boundary of the district, the assessments, total costs, and description of the parcels to be assessed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby specifically finds and declares that the actions authorized hereby constitute and are with respect to public affairs of the City, and that the statements, findings and determinations of the City set forth in the preambles above and of the documents approved herein are true and correct.

- Section 2. The City Council hereby declares its intention to form Lancaster Business Park Landscape Maintenance District pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972," as set forth in Part 2 of Division 15 (Sections 22500 et seq.) of said Code, to provide for the continued maintenance, operation and servicing of the Landscape Areas, and all landscape improvements thereto. Further, this Council hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments to pay all costs and expenses incurred pursuant to and in accordance with said Act. The proposed assessments are more particularly described in the Assessment for the District on file with the City Clerk.
- Section 3. The improvements shall include the maintenance, servicing and energy costs including all incidental expenses thereof of the landscaping improvements installed by the Lancaster Redevelopment Agency, within the Lancaster Business Park Landscape Maintenance District.
- Section 4. At least 45 days prior to the public hearing, the City Clerk shall cause a notice of the adoption of the Resolution of Initiating Proceedings, the filing of the preliminary Engineer's Report, a ballot for voting and the setting of time and place for said public hearing hereof to be mailed, postage prepaid, to all persons owning real property proposed to be assessed and whose names and addresses appear on the last equalized County of Los Angeles assessment roll or the State Board of Equalization assessment roll, as the case may be, or who are known to the City Clerk. Such notice shall conform in all respects to the provisions of Section 53753 of the California Government Code.
- Section 5. A public hearing shall be held on January 28, 2014 at 5:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, at the regular meeting place of the City Council, City Hall, 44933 N. Fern Avenue, Lancaster, California, to hear and consider protests and objections to the formation of the Assessment District and the Engineer's Report and to receive and count the ballots for and against the formation of the Assessment District.

ENGINEER'S REPORT RELATIVE TO

LANCASTER BUSINESS PARK LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015

PURPOSE

This report is submitted to request that the City Council declare its intention to initiate and conduct special assessment proceedings pursuant to provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 being Part 2, Division 15 (Section 22500 et seq.) of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

COST ESTIMATE

Previously the owners in the Lancaster Business Park were billed annually for the maintenance of landscaping in front of their properties and the Business Center Parkway median, which involves labor and equipment, repair and irrigation supplies, fertilizer, utilities, etc.

Based on the landscape maintenance contract, the cost associated with maintaining the 370,066 square feet of assessment area is \$52,035.00. Based on this figure and previous operating costs, the annual budget has been calculated as follows:

The formula used to calculate the owner's assessment is as follows: The total cost of landscape maintenance divided by the total landscape assessment district area, multiplied by the landscaped area associated with each owner's property, adjusted annually based on the Consumer Price Index.

Assessment =
$$((\$98,500/370,066 \text{ SF}) \text{ (Landscaped Area at each property)})$$

= $((\$.266/\text{SF}) \text{ (Landscaped Area at each property)})$

The new assessments have been tabulated for each property owner indicating the specific costs for the maintenance of landscaping at each property (See Exhibit "B"). The cost to maintain the landscaping for each property will stay the same as the previous agreement in fiscal year 2014-2015. The assessment may be adjusted annually based on the Consumer Price Index in subsequent years.

IMPROVEMENTS

This scope of work establishes the standards for maintenance of the landscaped areas for the City of Lancaster's Landscape Maintenance District encompassing the 74 lots (370,066 square feet of landscaped area) in the Lancaster Business Park, including areas immediately in front of business owner's properties and the Business Center Parkway median.

The highest standards of quality and maintenance will be adhered to and include maintenance of plant material and irrigation systems. Maintenance of plant material shall include, but not be limited to, mowing, trimming, tumbleweed and trash removal, aeration, weed control, cultivation, pest control, tree staking and tying, thatching, hedge pruning, and cleanup of drainage facilities. It is the intent to provide plant material maintenance methods to keep the site in a state of growth and repair. Irrigation maintenance shall include operation of system, adjustment, the reporting of needed repairs, and programming of irrigation schedules.

ASSESSMENT DISRICT FORMATION

By action of the City Council of the City of Lancaster, a Resolution was adopted initiating proceedings for formation of Lancaster Business Park Landscape Maintenance District (hereinafter referred to as the "District") for the payment of all costs required to provide for the continued maintenance, operation and servicing of landscape improvements pursuant to provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 being Part 2, Division 15 (Section 22500 et seq.) of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and in addition, the Utility Services Manager was directed to prepare a written Engineer's Report and file it with the City Clerk pursuant to Section 22565 of the Streets and Highways Code and Article XIIID of the California Constitution. This report was prepared in response to that directive.

Plans and Specifications indicating the general nature, location and extent of improvements are, or will be, on file with the City Clerk of the City of Lancaster and are hereby made a part hereof by reference. The attached Exhibit "A" identifying the boundary of the property forming the new Landscape Maintenance District to be assessed is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The revenue derived from the proposed assessment will be used to maintain, operate and service the landscape improvements within the District.

State Law indicates that an assessment district shall consist of all territory which, as determined by the legislative body, will receive special benefit from the improvements and is to be assessed to pay the costs thereof.

All of the area within the District receives special benefit by the landscape improvements installed within the District. The cost of maintenance, operation and servicing of the improvements in the District is to be assessed according to the Basis of Benefit Proportioning approved by the City Council. The amount of the proposed assessment for each parcel is as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and which is made a part hereof.

The annual aggregate amount of the assessment and the estimated annual cost of providing maintenance, operation and servicing of the landscape improvements is shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and which is made a part hereof. All revenue derived from the assessment will not be used to pay the cost of any service other than the service for which the assessment is levied.
