**Recommendation:**

Approve an appropriation in the amount of \$1,500 to Account No. 106-4644-772 for the Lancaster-West Rotary Club Youth/Community Service Grant and increase Revenue Account No. 106-3208-103 by the same amount.

**Fiscal Impact:**

\$1,500 YSA Grant; there is no match requirement and no general fund impact.

**Background:**

Lancaster was awarded \$1,500 by Lancaster-West Rotary Club for the Open Studio classes hosted by the Special Classes & Facility Rental Division of the Parks, Recreation & Arts Department. Lancaster-West Rotary was the first Rotary Club in the Antelope Valley and was founded in 1948. They have a long tradition of supporting programs that enhance youth education as well as those that provide resources to seniors and veterans within the community. This grant was awarded by Lancaster-West Rotary to afford seniors enhanced access to stimulating activities and socialization by providing discounted registration rates for the City's Open Studio courses during FY 2014/2015. Grant funds will support model fees for this program, making it possible for the City to reduce registration rates to senior patrons.
