A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN SPACE DISTRICT FOR THE 5<sup>TH</sup> SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 2015 COMPETITIVE **EXCESS FUNDS** GRANT **PROGRAM** FUNDING FOR THE EASTSIDE POOL REFURBISHMENT PROJECT AND APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF A YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the people of the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 1992, and on November 5, 1996 enacted Los Angeles County Proposition A, Safe Neighborhood Parks, Gang Prevention, Tree-Planting, Senior and Youth Recreation, Beach and Wildlife Protection (the Propositions), which among other uses, provides funds to public agencies and nonprofit organizations in the County for the purpose of acquiring and/or development of facilities and open space for public recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Propositions also created the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District (the District) to administer said funds; and

WHEREAS, the District has set forth the necessary procedures governing application for grant funds under the Propositions, and

WHEREAS, the District's procedures require the City of Lancaster to certify, by resolution, the approval of the application before submission of said application(s) to the District; and

WHEREAS, said application contains assurances that the City of Lancaster must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster certifies, through this resolution, that the application is approved for submission to the District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster will enter into an Agreement with the District to provide funds for acquisition and development projects.

WHEREAS, the District's procedures require the adoption of a Youth Employment Plan for development projects by the governing body of the agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Approves the filing of an application with the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District for Funds for the above project; and
- Section 2. Certifies that the City of Lancaster understands the assurances and certification in the application form; and.
- Section 3. Certifies that the City of Lancaster has, or will have, sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project in perpetuity; and
- Section 4. Certifies that the City of Lancaster will sign and return, within 30 days, both copies of the project agreement sent by the District for authorizing signature; and
- Section 5. Approves the adoption of a Youth Employment Plan for the project (see attached); and
- Section 6. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, to conduct all negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so forth, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

# City of Lancaster Youth Employment Plan

### Eastside Pool Refurbishment Project

# **Project Description:**

The proposed project will encompass the refurbishment of the City of Lancaster's Eastside Pool Complex and additional new features to the facility. The full-sized aquatic complex includes a heated, indoor, ten-lane pool with complete locker rooms available for year-round use by our citizens. The pool and associated infrastructure is in need of repair and rehabilitation due to its age and heavy usage.

# Scope of Work:

The Scope of Work for this project includes several improvements and additions to the complex that will provide for better use of the facility and increase the safety of the participants. The largest of these is the replacement of the retractable sky light roof over the pool. This includes the design, fabrication and installation of 360 rafter/mullion connection brackets, installation of 180 new mullions, and 60 panes of clear laminated glass on three existing flat, bi-parting operable roofs.

The project also consists of several additional upgrades and features including the painting of the interior of the pool structure, re-surfacing of the pool deck, new partitions for the restrooms and showers, a variable speed pool pump, improvements to the lifeguard office and floor, and regrouting the shower tile.

The nature of the construction requires that all work be performed by skilled laborers; therefore, this project will not be appropriate for the employment of at-risk youth.
