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## 2. Transit-Overlay Development Zones

Location: Planning Area 1 is approximately 84 acres in size and is located

northeast of the Metrolink Station between Avenue I and Milling Street, and between Sierra Highway and Division Street. Planning Area 2 is approximately 102 acres in size and is located southeast of the Metrolink Station and south of Downtown Lancaster between Milling Street and Newgrove Street from Fern Avenue to Date Avenue, and between Newgrove Street and Avenue J from

Fern Avenue to Sierra Highway

Request: Adoption of regulatory changes, as follows:

• Amend the General Plan to revise the existing boundary of the Downtown Lancaster Transit Village District;

- Amend the General Plan to revise the text of Table VIII-1, General Plan Land Categories, related to the MU (Mixed Use) land use designation;
