Subject: **Acceptance of Improvements (Drainage Maintenance District Annexation No. 04-107, Conditional Use Permit No. 03-08; Downtown Renewal L. P., Located on the Northeast Corner of 10th Street West and Jackman Street)**

Recommendation:

Approve and accept for maintenance the work and materials for the drainage improvements for Drainage Maintenance District Annexation No. 04-107, installed by the developer of the subject project.

Fiscal Impact:

First year's maintenance cost of \$2,782.50 has been paid by the developer – Downtown Renewal L. P.; subsequent costs will be assessed against the benefiting properties.

Background:

On January 25, 2005, the Council adopted Resolution No. 05-24, confirming the diagram and assessment and ordering the annexation for Lancaster Drainage Benefit Assessment District Annexation No. 04-107.

The drainage improvements for this Drainage Benefit Assessment District, located on the northeast corner of 10th Street West and Jackman Street, have been installed by the developer according to the approved plans and specifications. The improvements have been completed to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works.
