Background:

The Lancaster Youth Commission was created by the City Council in January of 1992 to provide a forum for the students of Lancaster to give input regarding the needs and concerns of the youth of this community. Youth Commissioners are nominated by the high schools in the Lancaster area. The schools include: Antelope Valley, Bethel Christian, Lancaster, Eastside and Quartz Hill High School. The Commission meets once a month from the start of the school year until the end of May.

Each year the Commission develops a work plan that identifies projects that the group will work on for the year. The incoming members will also participate in several volunteer projects including the MLK Day of Service and the Lancaster Lunch Box program. The Commission also plays a vital role in the coordination of Youth in Government activities. Commissioners assist with participant recruitment, pre-planning event details and directing fellow students during all the scheduled events.
