Subject: **Award of Bid – Material Bid No. 614-15 - Screened Aggregate Material**

Recommendation:

Award Material Bid No. 614-15, Screened Aggregate Material, to CALMAT Company dba Vulcan Materials Company of Palmdale, California, in the amount of \$130,100.00, plus a 10% contingency, for the purchase and delivery of 5/16” screened aggregate to the City’s stockpile location; authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents. This contract was awarded to the lowest responsible bidder per California Public Contract Code Section 22038 (b).

Fiscal Impact:

\$143,110.00 (including 10% contingency); sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 210-12ST034-924.

Background:

This bid was issued to obtain aggregate material for a cooperative chip seal project with the County of Los Angeles. This project will conduct pavement maintenance in the form of chip seal to approximately 38 lane miles of shared roads within the jurisdiction of both agencies. These roads will be surfaced, sealed, and striped using City staff.

On April 1, 2015, at 3:00 p.m., the City held a bid opening for Material Bid No. 614-15 where one (1) sealed bid was received, opened, and read aloud. The bid was as follows:
