FY 2015-2016 Citywide Fee Schedule - Fees, Fines, Rates, and Charges

The FY 2014-15 Citywide Fee Schedule was adopted by the City Council on June 23, 2015 through Resolution Numbers xx-xxx and, xx-xxx which are included in this schedule.

The Finance Department is charged with the general maintenance of the Citywide Fee Schedule.

However, City Departments have a role in fee schedule policies and maintenance. All Departments that levy fees are responsible for:

- Including all fees which are levied in the Citywide Fee Schedule; and
- Proposing fees which reflect the cost of services provided by the City.

This includes reviewing requests to modify the document, periodic review of fees to assure that they are equitable and reflect the cost of services, and preparation of transmittals to the City Council for recommended changes to fees annually.

Specific public notifications and procedures are legally mandated. A notice of a public hearing regarding the fees is published. In addition, the Office of the City Clerk will mail information regarding proposed modifications to any interested party who has filed a written request with the City Clerk for such notice. The Council then holds a public hearing regarding any proposed changes before adoption of revisions. All new and revised fee proposals are reviewed by the City Council and, if adopted, incorporated into this schedule.

- WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has adopted Ordinance No. 848 and Resolution No. 05-222 establishing a biological impact fee; and
