Subject: **Award of Bid - Public Works Construction Project No. 13-027
Avenue L and Challenger Way Roundabout, HSIPL-5419(033)**

Recommendations:

- a. Award Public Works Construction Project No. 13-027, Avenue L and Challenger Way Roundabout HSIPL-5419(033) to ANM Construction and Engineering of Lancaster, California, in the amount of \$1,185,000.00, plus a 10% contingency, for construction of a single lane roundabout. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents.
- b. Transfer \$750,000.00 from Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 232-15ST046-924 to Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 232-16ST003-924 and transfer \$150,000.00 from Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 232-15ST048-924 to Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 232-16ST003-924.

This contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder per California Public Contract Code Section 22038 (b).

Fiscal Impact:

\$1,303,500.00 (including 10% contingency); with these actions, sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account Numbers 232-16ST003-924, 261-16ST003-924 and 399-16ST003-924. Associated annual maintenance costs are \$7,035.00.

Background:

This project includes the construction of a single lane roundabout at the intersection of Avenue L and Challenger Way and the restriping of Avenue L from Sierra Highway to Challenger Way.

This project is partially funded by a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant, and therefore, the City of Lancaster is prohibited from applying the Local Hiring Preference requirements. Per Local Hiring Ordinance No. 977, the City shall not apply the Local Hiring Preference when a State or Federal law or regulation prohibits the use of a Local Hiring requirement.

On May 14, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 13-027. Three (3) sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:
