Subject: Summary Approval for all California Integrated Waste Management

Board Grants

Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution No. 07-130, approving the submittal of grant applications to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for all available used oil and household hazardous waste grants as listed under the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act or the California Integrated Waste Management Act.

Background:

The California Integrated Waste Management Board requires local government resolutions be submitted with each and every grant application submitted. A substantial amount of time is necessary to generate resolutions and staff reports, meet agenda schedules, and submit the application to the State under specific timelines.

Summary:

As Requests for Projects are released by the California Integrated Waste Management Board for future grant applications, this will allow City staff to work under specific deadlines to submit applications without submitting and obtaining resolutions for each individual grant. This would be a blanket resolution for all grant applications submitted.
