Avenue K-8 Bike Path Improvements, BTA 12/13-07-LA-06

Recommendation:

Award Public Works Construction Project No. 14-008, Avenue K-8 Bike Path Improvements, BTA 12/13-07-LA-06, to Granite Construction Company of Lancaster, California, in the amount of \$951,181.00, plus a 10% contingency, for road widening and bike path improvements and authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents.

This contract is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder per California Public Code Section 22038 (b).

Fiscal Impact:

\$1,046,299.10 (including 10% contingency) to be awarded; sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account Nos. 208-15BW007-924, 252-15BW007-924, and 399-15BW007-924. Associated annual maintenance costs are estimated to be \$7,500.00.

Background:

This project will construct bike path improvements from Sierra Highway to 15th Street West, along Avenue K-8, as well as a new signalized pedestrian crossing at Sierra Highway and Avenue K-8 and signal improvements at Avenue K-8 and 10th Street West.

On December 16, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 14-008. Four (4) sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:
