**Background:**

Development Services staff routinely submits applications to CalRecycle in order to receive payment program funds for Beverage Recycling and Used Oil. Due to recent evaluations of and revisions to CalRecycle's Payment Program, an approved resolution is now required authorizing the submittal of the applications and use of the funds. These funds are utilized to increase beverage container recycling and assist in the operation of the City's Recycling Center.

All awarded CalRecycle funds directly support our efforts to increase services for our citizens and the community as a whole. Additionally, this program conforms to the City of Lancaster's "Going Green" philosophy and works in harmony with the goals and directives of the Development Services Department's environmental compliance objectives and community service goals.
