#### **Recommendation:**

Adopt Ordinance No. 1018, amending title 15 of the Lancaster Municipal Code by repealing Ordinance Number 994, and adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Building Code as amended herein; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Residential Code as amended herein; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Electrical Code as amended herein; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Mechanical Code; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Plumbing Code as amended herein; adopting the Lancaster Security Code as contained herein; adopting by reference the 2015 edition of the International Property Maintenance Code as amended herein; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Energy Code as amended herein; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Historical Building Code; adopting by reference the 2017 edition of the Los Angeles County Fire Code; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Green Building Standards Code; adopting by reference the 2016 edition of the California Existing Building Code; and adopting by reference the 2016 California Referenced Standards code, as the Lancaster codes for buildings and construction, all pertaining to life and safety and to the construction, alteration, moving demolition, repair, maintenance, and use of buildings, structures, and properties within the City.

### **Fiscal Impact:**

By adopting the 2016 California Codes, with minimal amendments, the City will ensure that the City's codes for building and construction reflect the most current industry and regulatory standards, including those related to health and safety. The City still retains the option to adopt more restrictive measures as desired in the future.
