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COMMISSION PRESENTATIONS, DISCUSSION & DIRECTION

1. Department of Mental Health, LA County, Whole Person Care Division Presenter: Jessica Valencia and Douglas Emert

Whole Person Care - Los Angeles (WPC-LA) is a program that brings together health and social service agencies to build an integrated system that delivers seamless, coordinated services to LA County's most vulnerable Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are high risk, high users of hospital and emergency departments. WPC-LA connects people experiencing homelessness, justice involvement, barriers to healthy pregnancy, serious mental illness, substance use disorder or complex health conditions to resources and support.

2. Military Resource, Mental Health America of Los Angeles Presenter: Yvonne Oien, Assistant Program Manager

Louis Borrayo and David Neptune, Outreach and Diversion Specialists – spoke about the program that helps veterans and their families who are homeless or at serious risk of homelessness. The program offers help to rapidly locate housing, funds for urgent needs, and linkage to long-term solutions for health, financial, work and other family needs.

Provided are service coordination to develop and implement housing stability and personal service plans based on each member's individual needs, they assist members with obtaining VA and other public benefits and make connections to mental and physical health, education, and disability resources.

PUBLIC BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR - NON-AGENDIZED ITEMS

David Paul – discussed a documentary he watched, substance abuse, craziness of the world, a new acronym, his personal experiences, a past meeting he attended, and thanked the Commission for the meeting.

Destiny Sanchez – addressed and asked the commission on how to navigate the system and asked that more training is needed for advocates.

Connie Wong and Shannon Tucker- discussed their non-profit program "A change has come", and their personal experiences when dealing with the homeless population.
