Chairman Vose called the regular meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

1. Approval of Regular Minutes of November 18, 2019

PC Agenda Minutes January 27, 2020

Vice Chair Smith made a motion, and Commissioner Harvey seconded the motion for the approval of the November 18, 2019 Minutes.

CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARINGS

2. Tentative Tract Map No. 71210 & Conditional Use Permit No. 15-19

Item was continued from the November 18, 2019 Meeting due to the applicant's failure to post a sign on the subject property.

Since there were no public speakers, and a staff report was not requested to be heard, Chairman Vose closed the public hearing.

Commissioner Harvey made a motion, and Commissioner Moore seconded the motion to adopt Resolution No. 19-37 approving Tentative Tract Map No. 71210 and Conditional Use Permit No. 15-19 to allow for a Residential Planned Development of 169 single-family residential lots in the R-10,000 zoning designation and adopt the mitigated negative declaration.

NEW PUBLIC HEARINGS

4. <u>Tentative Parcel Map No. 82826</u>

Senior Planner, Jocelyn Swain, presented the staff report.

Chairman Vose clarified that there was an active Conditional Use Permit that has been extended from the initial hearing a few years ago. The approval of the parcel map will tie to the Conditional Use Permit, and the expiration dates would be the same. The Valley Fever condition was added to the Conditions of Approval. Any other project with CEQA clearance would have the condition added on the development side when pulling permits. The language for the Valley Fever condition is similar to the language that is already required by the Air District.

PC Agenda Minutes January 27, 2020

Vice Chair Smith made a motion, and Commissioner Moore seconded the motion to adopt Resolution No. 20-02 approving Tentative Parcel Map (TPM) No. 82826 to allow for the subdivision of 32.75 gross acres into 16 lots in the SP 95-02 zone located at the southeast corner of William J. Barnes and 47th Street West.
