

CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF  
BALLOT MEASURE C RELATING TO  
ESTABLISHING A DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAM

The City Council (the "City Council") of the City of Lancaster (the "City"), on November 14, 2023, adopted Resolution 23-68 submitting Measure C to the voters at the general municipal election to be held on April 9, 2024. The ballot measure asks whether the City Council should establish a drug treatment program similar to Teen Challenge. Measure H is an advisory measure and, without binding the City, would advise the City Council as to whether it should establish a drug treatment program similar to Teen Challenge.

In order for Measure C to be approved, a majority of the votes cast must be in favor of the Measure.

A "yes" vote for Measure C will advise the City Council to establish a drug treatment program similar to Teen Challenge.

A "no" vote against Measure C will not advise the City Council to establish a drug treatment program similar to Teen Challenge.
