TERM OF OFFICE

Four-year terms -- Beginning April 2024 and ending April 2028

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates must be 18 years of age, a Citizen of the United States, and a registered voter residing within the city limits at the time nomination papers are issued.

NOMINATION PERIOD

Opens: Monday, December 18, 2023

Holidays: City Hall will be closed on December 25-26; January 1-2, 2024*

<u>Closes</u>: Friday, January 12, 2024 unless an incumbent does not file, then the period is extended to Wednesday, January 17, 2024.

NOMINATION PAPERS AND / OR CANDIDATE'S HANDBOOKS:

Will be available on the first day of the nomination period, Monday, December 18th. "Pulling" nomination papers will take approximately 45 minutes, **so an appointment is requested.**

COST

There is no cost to be issued nomination papers, receive a Candidate's Handbook, which is provided free to all persons considering becoming a candidate; there is a \$25 fee to file nomination papers.

If a candidate chooses to submit a candidates statement, there is a fee of \$2,200 (English only) and \$4,400 for both English and Spanish to cover the printing and distribution of that statement in the sample ballot.

MAIL BALLOTS WILL BE MAILED BEGINNING MARCH 11TH

By law, Vote-by-Mail ballots cannot be mailed out earlier than Monday, March 11th. Ballots received up to the Friday following the election (April 12th) that are postmarked on or before election day will be counted as part of the Official Canvass.

CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

All candidates must file all forms required by the Political Reform Act.
