Questions:

- 1. Is the City willing to waive consultant minimum requirements 1, 2, and 9?
- 2. If the City is willing to waive the above requirements, can a 2-week extension be aranted?
- 3. Can the City provide additional guidance/clarification on the cost proposal?
- 4. Can you please clarify what you require as a "curriculum sample"?
- 5. Are the required forms and copies of licenses excluded from the page count?
- 6. Given that the RFP was posted on 7/16 for a fairly critical scope to Lancaster Energy's hydrogen aspirations, can the due date of the proposal submittal be extended to 8/30 via addenda to proposal?
- 7. Can the minimum requirements #1 and #2 as pertaining to accreditation by NAESCO and DOE be completed past the due date for proposal?

Answers:

- 1. While meeting all the consultant requirements is preferred, we strongly encourage you to apply to this RFQ if you don't meet those requirements.
- 2. The final due date for this RFQ will be extended to August 13, 2024, 2:00 P.M.
- 3. We are seeking detailed cost estimates encompassing all phases of the project, including design, implementation, equipment procurement, and ongoing maintenance considerations. Please ensure your cost proposal outlines a clear breakdown of costs, including any anticipated expenses related to hydrogen infrastructure development and integration with existing systems.
- 4. Please disregard the phrase "curriculum sample." The phrase was not intended to be included in this RFQ.

- 5. The required forms and copies of licenses are excluded from the page count.
- 6. The final due date for this RFQ will be extended to August 13, 2024, 2:00 P.M.
- 7. As per answer 1, the City encourages all consultants to apply to this RFQ if you do not meet the minimum requirements.
