Reasons why project is exempt: The proposed project involves construction of two new industrial buildings, a total of 73,320 square-feet, and operation of retail sales of cannabis in a 2,922 square-foot existing building, on a 3.88-acre site in the Light Industrial (LI) zone. The proposal is consistent with the applicable general plan designation and all applicable general plan policies, zoning designations, and regulations. The site is substantially surrounded by urban uses and has no value as habitat for endangered, rare, or threatened species. Approval of the project will not result in any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality. All required utilities and public services are available to adequately serve the site.

None of the identified exceptions (cumulative impact, significant effect, scenic highways, hazardous waste sites, or historical resources) apply to the proposed project. Impacts associated with the proposed project would be minimal and would not create significant impacts to any of the resources identified in Appendix G of the CEQA Guidelines.
