Questions & Answers:

1. Can you provide some examples of municipal code violations that might be cited for prosecution?

The City anticipates that in addition to existing municipal code provisions, the City will seek authority to prosecute state law misdemeanors and/or to-be-enacted amendments to the municipal code to mirror state law to the extent permitted by law. The City expects to focus considerable effort in this area of enforcement.

Additional codes the City may seek to prosecute include:

8.28.030 Excessive junk, trash and/or debris hazard; abandoned structures Title 9 of the Lancaster Municipal Code, including:

9.04.010 Furnish Weapon to minor

9.04.060 Discharge firearm in city limits

9.16 Loitering by minor

9.20.030 Consume alcohol public street/parking lot

9.50.030 Human Trafficking; Drug Activity: Public Nuisance

12.04.140 Disturb Peace

12.04.360 Illegal Dumping

12.04.600 Trespassing

15.08.010 Un-permitted construction

2. Can you provide a projection of how many municipal code criminal citations might be referred for prosecution per month?

As this program is new to the City, precise estimates are not possible. A rough approximation of 20-30 referrals from Lancaster Police Department are anticipated per month and 5-7 cases per month from Code Enforcement.
