#### Questions & **Answers:**

1. Can you provide some examples of municipal code violations that might be cited for prosecution?

**The City anticipates that in addition to existing municipal code provisions, the City will seek authority to prosecute state law misdemeanors and/or to-be-enacted amendments to the municipal code to mirror state law to the extent permitted by law. The City expects to focus considerable effort in this area of enforcement.**

**Additional codes the City may seek to prosecute include:**

**8.28.030 Excessive junk, trash and/or debris hazard; abandoned structures**

**Title 9 of the Lancaster Municipal Code, including:**

**9.04.010 Furnish Weapon to minor**

**9.04.060 Discharge firearm in city limits**

**9.16 Loitering by minor**

**9.20.030 Consume alcohol public street/parking lot**

**9.50.030 Human Trafficking; Drug Activity: Public Nuisance**

**12.04.140 Disturb Peace**

**12.04.360 Illegal Dumping**

**12.04.600 Trespassing**

**15.08.010 Un-permitted construction**

2. Can you provide a projection of how many municipal code criminal citations might be referred for prosecution per month?

**As this program is new to the City, precise estimates are not possible. A rough approximation of 20-30 referrals from Lancaster Police Department are anticipated per month and 5-7 cases per month from Code Enforcement.**
