Project Description: The City of Lancaster in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to construct safety improvements to the at-grade crossing at the intersection of Avenue J and the Railroad facilities near Sierra Highway. Both the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) and the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA) own facilities within the project area.
