Subject: **Award of Bid - Public Works Construction Project No. 08-004
2008 Alley Reconstruction Program**

Recommendation:

Award Public Works Construction Project No. 08-004, 2008 Alley Reconstruction Program to Padilla Paving in the amount of \$234,050.00, (plus 10% contingency) for the construction of 2008 Alley Reconstruction Program. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents.

Fiscal Impact:

\$257,455.00 (including 10% contingency); sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account Number 361-12ST021-924.

Background:

As part of the City's ongoing efforts to upgrade existing City streets, this project is designed to repair and resurface the alleyway from Milling Street to Avenue J, between Cedar Avenue and Elm Avenue.

On Wednesday, March 12, 2008, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 08-004. Seven sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:
