Discuss and consider appointments to various committees/organizations.

**Background:**

At the City Council meeting of April 22, 2008, the City Council approved appointments to three organizations. Those organizations were: Antelope Valley Air Quality Management District (AVQMD); Antelope Valley Transit Authority (AVTA); Sanitation District #14.

All other committee appointments were continued to the meeting of May 13, 2008 to allow for discussion from a full City Council.

As part of the reorganization of the City Council, there are legislative bodies that require by statute or by agreement (i.e. JPA) appointments to committees and/or organizations by the Council.

Attached is a list of organizations identified by staff, which need immediate appointments.

<b>Organization</b>	<b>Appointment</b>	<b>Meeting Dates/Times</b>
North County Transportation Coalition (NCTC)	Requires one elected official; one representative appointed by Council from a business organization. Current staff liaison: Nicole West, Management Analyst I – Public Works Department	Meets at various times and at various locations.
High Desert Corridor (JPA)	Requires one elected official plus one alternate (alternate need not be an elected official). Current staff liaison and TAC Member: Nicole West, Management Analyst I – Public Works Department	Meets at various times and at various locations.
Southern California Association of Governments Regional Council	Requires one elected official and this person will also serve on SCAG’s Community Economic & Human Development Committee; the Transportation & Communication Policy Committee and/or the Energy & Environment Committee	Meets on the first Thursday of each month – 11:30 a.m. to 1:15 p.m. in Los Angeles.
League of California Cities (Desert Mountain Division)	Requires the Mayor plus one alternate.	Quarterly – 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and at various locations.
League of California Cities (Los Angeles County Division)	Requires the Mayor plus one alternate.	First Thursday of each month- 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in Los Angeles.
EAFB Restoration Advisory Board (RAB)	Staff Liaison – Peter Zorba Alternate – Henry Hearn	Meets at various times.
