Subject: Vacation of Road Right-of-Way Located on West Avenue L

Recommendation:

Adopt **Resolution No. 08-81**, declaring its intention to vacate road right-of-way located at West Avenue L and West Avenue L South Ramp.

Fiscal Impact:

Background:

Public Works has received a request from the property owner for the vacation of excess road right-of-way on Avenue L, located between Avenue L South Ramp and the Avenue L overpass of Sierra Highway. The City no longer requires the excess right-of-way. This vacation would eliminate the road right-of-way as shown on Exhibit "A".

In order to proceed with the road right-of-way vacation, Staff recommends October 28, 2008, be set as the date of the public hearing to receive testimony relative to the vacation.

RESOLUTION NO. 08-81

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO VACATE A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY, LOCATED AT WEST AVENUE L AND WEST AVENUE L SOUTH RAMP.

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is holder of easement rights of a road right-of-way, recorded in Book 217, page 27 of maps in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County; (see Exhibit "A") and

WHEREAS, Rare Properties, LLC, intends to develop the site and requires the vacation of the road right-of-way to proceed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, State of California, that:

- Section 1. The public interest, convenience, and necessity so requiring, it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Lancaster to vacate the road right-of-way in accordance with Section 5400 of the California Health and Safety Code.
- Section 2. The City Council does hereby declare its intention to vacate that certain road right-of-way to the owners of record.
- Section 3. Said vacation has been duly recommended for approval based on the fact that the road right-of-way is not required for road purposes; therefore, the subject vacation is not objectionable.
- Section 4. The 28th day of October, 2008 at the hour of 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Lancaster City Hall, 44933 Fern Avenue, Lancaster, is hereby designated as the date, time, and place at which a public hearing will be held before the Lancaster City Council to discuss the proposed vacation. At that time, all persons with interest in or objection to the proposed vacation, may appear and be heard.
- Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to post notices of said proposed vacation conspicuously along the line of the road right-of-way thereof proposed to be vacated at least two weeks prior to the date of said hearing. Such notices shall be prepared and posted pursuant to Section 8323 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California. Further, the City Clerk shall notice the meeting and hearing in accordance with Section 8322 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
