Under 18 Years of Age


Percentage of Population Under Age 18 Per Neighborhood










Percentage of Population Under Age 65 and Older Per Neighborhood










Median Annual Household Income Per Neighborhood



Locations of Rental Housing (Parcels)






Presence of Rental Housing (By Census Blocks)

(Neighborhood Percentages)






Presence of Section 8 Housing (By Census Blocks)












Presence of Section 8 Housing (Neighborhood Totals)








Section 8 Housing As % of Total Housing Units

(By Census Blocks)


Percentage of Housing Units that are Section 8 Per Census Block










Section 8 Housing As % of Total Housing Units

Percentage of Housing Units that are Section 8 Per Neighborhood








Presence of Code Violations (By Census Blocks)






Incidence of Narcotics Violations - 2005


Incidence of Robbery - 2005







Key Indicators With High Age of Housing Stock








