PROPOSED FY 2006/2007 OPERATING BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM NB 1. The City Manager/Executive Director presented an overview of the proposed Fiscal Year 2006/2007 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Program. The presentation included information on aligning the budget with Council Vision and Goals; State of Economy; Future Fiscal Issues; moving towards the 2020 Plan. Background was given regarding the Citizen Survey; Strategic Workshop; 2005/06 Initiatives. Information was given regarding new growth challenges; the National Economy; the State Economy and the impact this will have on Lancaster. Housing growth was discussed, along with home prices; municipal costs and City services.
