**Maintenance Yard Improvements** 

## **Recommendation:**

Reject all bids for Public Works Construction Project No. 07-037, Maintenance Yard Improvements, and authorize staff to modify the plans to reduce the scope of work to meet the available budget and re-bid the modified project.

## **Background:**

The project included improvements to the City of Lancaster Maintenance Yard. The scope of the project included a construction of a new storage building, ten (10) compressed natural gas fueling stations, solar shade structure and connections for an emergency generator.

The eight bids received were slightly higher than the engineer's estimate and significantly exceed the project budget. The project was bid with several items being provisionary; unfortunately even the base bid for the low responsive bidder was far above the engineer's estimate and project budget.

On April 29, 2009, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 07-037. Eight sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The base bids for all bids were as follows:
