# MEETING LANCASTER ARCHITECTURAL AND DESIGN COMMISSION

June 26, 2009

## **CALL TO ORDER**

Vice Chair Harvey called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

#### **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Commissioner Donlon led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

#### ROLL CALL

#### **NEW ITEM**

### 1. <u>DISCUSSION OF ONLINE SURVEY</u>

Chuen Ng mentioned that Mayor Parris was pleased with the progress of the commission.

Chris Aune presented the survey contents and showed the set-up whereby 2 photos are shown and responders will be asked to choose which photo they prefer. The photos he took were supposed to take up the architectural features that the commission has been discussing, namely: residential landscaped parkways, front elevation, view from the street, alley, perimeter walls, connectivity, view corridor, wall signages, side street elevations, corner features, monument signs, entry features and parking structures. There were also photos of multiple family residences, medical buildings, light industrial offices, mini storage, service stations and auto malls.

The commissioners noted that photos should not be too extreme and that comparisons made have to be like for like. They suggested that it would be good to state the intent of what the commission is trying to accomplish, ask specific questions (instead of the generic "Which do you prefer?"), and indicate the verbiage of the guidelines so that responders know what specific architectural feature they are focusing on when looking at the photos.

They also thought that it would be good to give responders the choice of checking off one of the following options after each question: • Strongly Agree • Agree • Neutral • Disagree • Strongly Disagree; and to allow them to state a reason for their response.

Chris Aune will bring the survey back to the commission for a final review at the next meeting.
