Background:

On March 18, 1996, the City Council appointed thirty-two citizens to the Lancaster Veterans Home Citizens Committee and approved its By-laws and Articles of Incorporation. Thirty-five is the maximum number of members allowed by the By-laws. Since May 1996, the City Council has approved numerous applications of individuals to fill vacancies on the Committee as they have occurred.

The Lancaster Veterans Home Citizens Committee intermittently has resignations throughout the year. This often creates problems in continuity, quorums, meeting schedules, and resolution of issues. There are currently two (2) vacancies on the 35-member committee.

Five applicants have submitted applications and volunteered to serve on the Lancaster Veterans Home Citizens Committee. The recommendation is for the City Council to approve Betty J. Thomas, Emily A. Pack, Emery E. Pack, Lonny Potter and Micky Palmer to fill current and future vacancies on the Lancaster Veterans Home Citizens Committee.
