Subject: **Award of Bid - Public Works Construction Project No. 08-009
Avenue K and 50th Street West Improvements ESPL 5419-(020)**

Recommendation:

Award Public Works Construction Project No. 08-009, Avenue K and 50th Street West Improvements ESPL 5419-(020), to Imperial Paving Company, Inc., in the amount of \$295,485.00 plus a 10% contingency. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to sign all documents. Appropriate \$325,040.00 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant funds to Capital Improvements Budget Account No. 383-12ST017-924.

Fiscal Impact:

\$325,040.00 (including 10% contingency); with these actions, sufficient funds are available in Capital Improvements Budget Account Nos. 383-12ST017-924 and 206-12ST017-924. There are no annual maintenance costs associated with this project.

Background:

On February 17, 2009, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) was signed. ARRA provided \$27.5 billion in supplemental funding to Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) in which \$2.57 billion was apportioned to California. The City of Lancaster applied for the use of these funds through Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and has received \$4,247,000.00 in ARRA grant funds. Of these funds, \$416,000.00 has been earmarked for use on the Avenue K and 50th Street West Improvements.

The Avenue K and 50th Street West Improvements will provide for new paving on Avenue K approximately one-quarter mile west of 50th Street West and on 50th Street West approximately one-eighth mile south of Avenue K. This project will also improve drainage at the intersection of Avenue K and 50th Street West.

On August 19, 2009, at 11:00 a.m., the City conducted a bid opening for Public Works Construction Project No. 08-009. Ten sealed bid envelopes were received, opened, and read aloud. The bids were as follows:
