Subject: **Joint Tax Transfer Resolution for Proposed Annexation No. 2008-10 into Los Angeles County Mosquito and Vector Control District**

Recommendation:

Adopt the Joint Tax Transfer Resolution for proposed Annexation No. 2008-10 into the Los Angeles County Mosquito and Vector Control District, Antelope Valley.

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Background:

The property owners within Annexation No. 2008-10 are requesting mosquito and vector control service for their properties. Before mosquito and vector control service may be provided, the properties must first be annexed into Los Angeles County Mosquito and Vector Control District, Antelope Valley. Additionally, before annexation may be approved, the agencies already providing services to the sites must negotiate reallocation of the ad valorem taxes within the District.

Los Angeles County Mosquito and Vector Control District, Antelope Valley submitted a written request that the City of Lancaster consider a Joint Tax Transfer Resolution which will reallocate the ad valorem tax revenues generated by the properties within the proposed annexation. This Joint Tax Transfer Resolution will provide Los Angeles County Mosquito and Vector Control District, Antelope Valley with property tax revenues from the properties proposed for annexation into the District for the benefit of bringing a new service into the annexed territory.
